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WHO WE ARE

DJ Club CIC delivers hands-on DJ and music technology workshops for young people aged 3 to 21 across Essex and London. We work with groups of up to 12, using professional equipment to engage students who may not respond to traditional classroom approaches. All staff are enhanced DBS-checked with full safeguarding policies in place.

Every visit covers 2 different groups, so a block of 6 reaches 24 students. Two groups share the same travel and setup, which is why a visit costs less per head than a single session would. If you have only one group, tell us and we will look at pairing you with a nearby school.

A block of 6 reaches 24 students at **£150 per student** for the half term, or **£25 per student per session**. All prices include equipment, certificates, reporting and the Term 3 showcase. Eligible for Pupil Premium, SEND and enrichment budgets.

Six free demos are available this autumn, first come first served. If you go ahead after a trial, it counts as the first visit of your block, so you pay the balance rather than starting again.
